Rules for the 2011 DSC Members Trophy Awards

1. Any species of game animal legally taken in fair chase worldwide is eligible.
2. The animal must have been taken in the last 3 years prior to the convention, and the DSC member must have been a member when the animal was taken.
3. The SCI scoring system will be used. The trophies must be scored prior to the competition deadline date. Scores and score sheets must be included in all entry forms for the trophy to be eligible for any award.
4. Actual trophies are no longer required to be displayed at Dallas Convention Center. A field photo (digital format preferred) is required. Photos of all trophies entered in the competition will be displayed in the trophy competition area and/or membership booth. If you are interested in displaying your actual trophy, contact the chairman of the Wildlife Committee at least one week prior to convention to be included in the wildlife display. Animals will be displayed on a space availability basis.
5. Any trophy that has been entered in a previous DSC Trophy Awards cannot be re-entered.
6. All entry forms must be accompanied by a score sheet and field photo of the entrant and animal (digital format preferred). Photographs will be returned to the entrant upon request and may be used at the discretion of DSC.
7. All entries must be complete and received in the DSC offices by December 31, 2010. Incomplete entries will be carried over to the following year.
8. Any questions regarding rules or other issues will be decided by the Trophy Awards Committee. All judging decisions are final. No judge may have an entry in any category in the year that he or she will judge.

Entry fee is \$30.00 per animal. Fees are waived for all youth entries. Checks should be made payable to Dallas Safari Club. Entry fees must accompany entry form(s), or they may be charged on American Express, MasterCard or Visa.

Major Awards listed below - Recognizes the DSC member with a limited edition bronze sculpture on a walnut pedestal. There may be a 2nd and 3rd place award from each category listed below, excluding The President's Cup, at the discretion of the Trophy Awards Committee.

Best Of The Americas (North, South, Central)

"Louis Schreiner Memorial" - Best Of North America Introduced
Best Of Europe
Best Of Asia
Best Of South Pacific (Australia/New Zealand)

Best Of Whitetail Deer - High Fenced
Best Of Whitetail Deer - Free Ranging
Best Animal Taken By A Lady (DSC Member)
Best of Archery
Best of Handgun
Best Animal Taken By A Youth (21 Or Under & Must Be A DSC Member)

JUDGING CRITERIA:

Note: For North American Animal Entries, the Boone and Crocket System of measurement must be used. For Awards placement, the B and C gross score will be used by the judging panel.

1. Difficulty of Hunt for Type of Species
2. Rarity of Species
3. Desirability of Trophy
4. SCI Score, B & C Score, P&Y Score and Rank in Record Book
5. Method of Hunt
6. Fenced or Free Ranging, And Size of Enclosure If Fenced
7. Number of Species Ranked In Record Book in Recent Years

3. Representative from APHA
